

# 3. Setup Steps

## Step 1: Create the Local User

Run the following in an elevated Command Prompt:

```
net user "Padilla Reading Room" /add /active:yes
```

```
net localgroup Users "Padilla Reading Room" /add
```

Optionally set a blank password:

```
net user "Padilla Reading Room" ""
```

(Note: you can skip this if you create the account using “Other Users” in Windows Settings)

## Step 2: Download and Place DelProf2

1. Download from: <https://helgeklein.com/free-tools/delprof2-user-profile-deletion-tool/>
2. Extract and place **DelProf2.exe** in: **C:\Tools\DelProf2.exe**

## Step 3: Create the Cleanup Script

Create a new script: **C:\Tools\ResetPadillaProfile.cmd**

```
@echo off
```

```
echo [%date% %time%] Deleting Padilla Reading Room profile >>  
C:\Tools\ProfileReset.log
```

```
C:\Tools\DelProf2.exe /u /id:"Padilla Reading Room" >> C:\Tools\ProfileReset.log 2>&1
```

## Step 4: Set Up the Scheduled Task

1. Open Task Scheduler *as Administrator*
2. Create a new **Task** (*not* Basic Task)
3. On the **General** tab:

- Name: ResetPadillaProfile
- Run whether user is logged on or not
- Run with highest privileges
- Change user/group: set to SYSTEM

On the **Triggers** tab:

- New trigger: At startup

On the **Actions** tab:

- Start a program: C:\Tools\ResetPadillaProfile.cmd

Save and exit
