

# PcAnywhere 11 giving you errors at the login screen?

On the Windows taskbar, click Start > Run. The Run dialog box appears.

In the Run dialog box, type regedit in the Open: box.

Click OK.

In the Registry Editor dialog box, go to the key:

```
HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE>System>CurrentControlSet>Services>AW_HOST
```

In the right pane, click Start.

On the Edit menu, click Modify.

In the Edit DWORD Value window, change "Value Data" to 1.

Click OK.

Close the Registry Editor

The pcAnywhere 11.0 host will now start correctly.

## Technical Information:

This problem occurs if SysPrep modified the registry setting for AW\_HOST. To fix this problem, the DWORD value for AW\_HOST must be reset to its original value of "1."
