

Simplifying web-based processes with CoScripter

"IBM has a very cool Firefox-only plugin called CoScriptor which is sort of a macro recorder for Firefox:

<http://services.alphaworks.ibm.com/coscripter/browse/about>

There are a variety of scripts available for perusal, use, and editing. Scripts that get created using co-scriptor are automatically re-archived for others to use.

It could easily be used to automate a lot of support functions of the sort:

- 1 – go to this site
- 2 – click on this button
- 3 – type your university ID into this text box
- 4 – now click on submit
- 3 – now type in "change your email final delivery point:
- 4 – etc

All the above can be scripted with CoScriptor.
