## Laptops and tablets

## Cameras

- Video kits are available for loan from CLICC for anyone with a valid BruinCard. The video kits are charged through your library account – just like the laptop, books, and iPads. At this time, video kits are checked out for a period of two business days. There are currently two (2) GoPro kits available, as well as two (2) iPad video kits. Each kit contains a myriad of accessories designed for video production, and you can additionally check out other accessories like a tripod if needed.
